Interview Questions to Ask:	Notes:
How long have you been a pet sitter?	
Do you have experience with large dogs? (You can substitute "large" with "small" or with traits that your dog has, such as high energy, timid, etc.)	
Do you have any pets of your own?	
What do you like most about pet sitting?	
How many other pets are you currently sitting for?	
What are the different types of animals that you take care of as a pet sitter?	
Are you a full time pet sitter or do you have other obligations such as school or a job?	
Can you provide pet services such as pet clean up, dog walking, grooming or playtime?	
Do you charge for extra services such as watering the plants or bringing in the mail?	
Are you able to stay overnight?	
For daytime visits, how long are your visits? (Let the pet sitter know how many visits per day you need and how long you want each visit to be.)	
Can you provide timed visits to match my pet's current schedule?	



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During your visits, do you bring another adult or a child with you?	
How often will you contact me to let me know how the visits are going? (Let the pet sitter know how often you would like to be contacted.)	
Do you know pet first aid, including CPR?	
Are you able to give medications to my dog? (Let the pet sitter know what medications your dog needs.)	
What is your emergency backup plan in case you have a personal emergency or car problems and cannot pet sit?	
What is your availability by phone, email or text while we are gone?	
Do you have a pet sitting Facebook, Twitter or Linked In account?	
What are your rates and what does this include?	
What are your terms of payment?	
Can you provide a written contract that lists your daily services and fees?	
Can you provide at least 3 client references?	
Are you a member of a professional pet sitting association? Are you licensed, bonded and insured?
